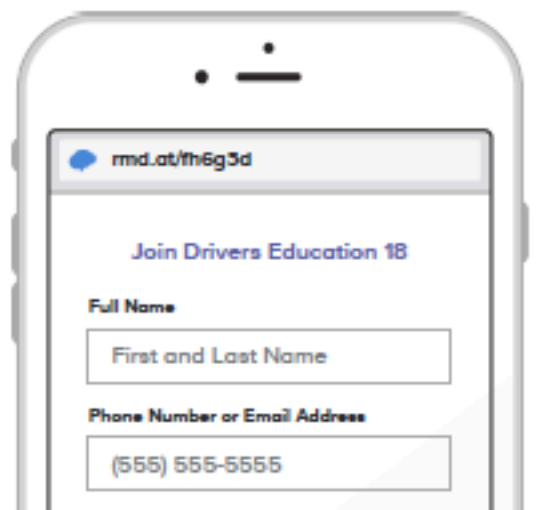

Driver's Education Policies and Procedures

Student Eligibility:

For a student to participate in the summer Driver Education program, he/she must turn fourteen prior to the start of the class session.

Attendance:

The Driver's Education Modules (tests/Quizzes) will be set up into five-week blocks. Students will need to successfully complete the modules (tests/quizzes) in a designated timeframe. The final exam will be completed at an assigned location at the end of the five-week block.

Grading Procedure:

Students must successfully complete both instructional modules according to (on-line and behind the wheel) the stated criteria, to pass the Driver Education course and receive credit.

Testing Procedure:

Students are required to successfully complete each test at 80% competency. A failure to score at least 80% on **chapter** tests will result in the student retaking the test. If a student does not achieve at least 80% mastery on the second test, special assistance by the instructor will be arranged by the instructor in order to complete the test. A final test will be given with a mastery of 80% to pass the curriculum. If a student fails the first final exam, a second test will be administered. If 80% is not completed, the student will fail the class.

Behind the Wheel Instruction:

No instructor will spend more than 8 hours per day in-car supervision of students. Each behind the wheel objective will be successfully completed to the unit mastery level. Due to the time frame of scheduling the student will not meet the objectives if more than two scheduled driving sessions are missed. A minimum of 4 hours of in car instruction is needed to complete behind the wheel course. Successful completion is determined when the student can consistently and correctly perform without instructor prompt the driving competency/task to the satisfaction of the instructor.

Student's Responsibilities:

Students must have a valid Kansas Driver's License or a learner's permit from the Motor Vehicle Department. Possession of the permit or license is required to operate the car. A student must meet all criteria of each lesson in order to pass the class.

Discipline:

Due to the serious nature of the material covered and the safety of others in the class, inappropriate student conduct may result in dismissal from the driver education program.

Course Fee:

A \$200.00 non-refundable course fee will be charged and is due at the time of enrollment.

PLEASE NOTE:

To Pass the Course: Student must have 80% mastery on unit tests and the final. Students are encouraged to do the chapter reviews at the end of the units to help prepare for each unit test, and to use a study guide for the final. All tests must be completed before taking the final exam.

High School Transcript: Upon completion of the Drivers Education course students will receive a quarter credit in high school. This is entered as a Pass/Fail grade and will not impact the students GPA.

Access to Online Coursework: Once students are enrolled, textbooks are online, if need be you may obtain a hard copy upon request.

Students may access coursework at their convenience via a web address and password that will be provided to you. Students will have access to Internet via Colby High School computer labs.

Students must finish coursework in the session they are enrolled.

If a student fails the first final exam, a second test will be administered. If 80% is not completed, the student will fail the class.

Agreement between the student, parent and school:

We understand that the instructor is to instruct and evaluate the proper way of driving. The limited amount of time will not be enough to develop proficient drivers, and parents should be prepared to provide additional practice time.

The Department of Motor Vehicles retains the right to not accept your student's Certificate of Completion. Ordinarily, they will grant the proper license as the age requirements are met, but your student could be required to take a written and/or a driving test.
